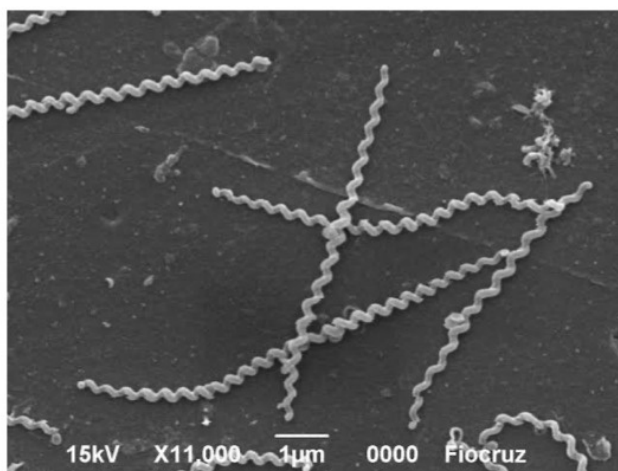




“Lepto infections increase across Northern Australia”

You, your pet, and/or your livestock are vulnerable to this disease

- There are **NO** human vaccines for “Lepto” yet it is zoonotic (can infect humans)
- **There are vaccines** for dogs & livestock so chat to your Veterinarian
- Northern States of Australia are seeing a **dramatic increase** in human and animal infections



Above: Is it a worm, is it a plane – Nah it’s an itty-bitty coiled bacterium called Leptospirosis or “Lepto”. There are hundreds of different strains globally

Livestock, pigs, companion animals, and most commonly vermin are carriers and spreaders of the bacteria in their urine.
